REMINDER: Please try not to take any antihistamine medications for 5 days prior to this appointment. That is, try to stop medicines like Benadryl, Fexofenadine (Allegra), Cetirizine (Zyrtec), Loratidine (Claritin or Alavert), Xyzal, Clarinex, Chlortimeton, and Hydroxyzine. Also, hold sleep medications with antihistamines like Nyquil, Sominex, and Tylenol PM, and hold any Cold and Flu medications that cause sleep or say PM.

You are fine to continue all other non-antihistamine medications. Please do continue your asthma medications, allergy cortisone nose sprays and other daily medications.

We do not allow cigarettes, smoking, vaping, or bringing any animals or pets to our office to protect our patient's and staff's health. We ask that you do not wear perfume, cologne or scented lotions to your appointment, as we do have patients who are allergic to them. We thank you in advance for your consideration.
